	<ul> <li>Internal Browning</li> </ul>
	Scald
_	<ul> <li>All defects as defined in EU Regulation No. 543/2011 Annex 1, Part B, Part 1, II, A. when applicable.</li> </ul>
SIGNIFICANT DEFECTS	May not exceed 3% of sample size as described
	<ul> <li>Apple Scab/Black Spot: When more than three spots of 2 mm diameter on a single fruit</li> </ul>
	Bitter Pit
	<ul> <li>Bruising – major: Greater than 1cm<sup>2</sup> and the flesh is discoloured deeper than 2mm</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Cracks – major: Open cracks showing the flesh of the apple</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Greasiness: When fruit is sticky or when fingerprints can be left on the epidermis</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Hail Marks – major: When skin is injured, or flesh is discoloured</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Insect Damage – major: Fresh unhealed damage or when skin penetration results in flesh discolouration or</li> </ul>
	with evidence of excrement
	<ul> <li>Skin Penetrations such as stalk or mechanical injuries: When two marks greater than 3 mm diameter on a</li> </ul>
	single fruit. European market: Apples must be intact with no skin penetrations
	<ul> <li>Sunburn – major: When flesh is discoloured</li> </ul>
	TOTAL MAJOR + SIGNIFICANT DEFECTS MAY NOT EXCEED 3% OF SAMPLE SIZE
	<ul> <li>Blemishes such as scars, scratches, rub marks and frost injury: When a single mark is more than 20 mm long or a total area greater than 1 cm<sup>2</sup> on a single fruit</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Bruising – minor: When bruised area is greater than 1 cm<sup>2</sup></li> </ul>
	Chemical Burn: When surface colour is affected
	<ul> <li>Calyx end cracks – minor: Light healed cracks around greater than half of calyx basin</li> </ul>
	Dirty fruit: Fruit must be clean, but dust allowed in lower halves of stem and calyx ends <sup>1</sup>
	• Hail Marks – minor: When more than two light marks less than 2 mm diameter on a single fruit and no more
S	than 1 mm depth or 2 mm high
MINOR	<ul> <li>Hammering and Ridging: When surface is discoloured</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Insect Damage – minor: When superficial mark (no skin penetration) with an area greater than 3 mm</li> </ul>
	Lenticel Damage: When more than two spots greater than 1 mm diameter on a single fruit
	Malformations: When malformations more than 10 mm on a single fruit
	Net like russet: When rough to touch and surface colour is affected
	<ul> <li>Flyspeck and Sooty Blotch: When greater than 1 cm<sup>2</sup> on a single fruit</li> </ul>
	Russet: When extended outside the stem end and calyx basin
	Sunburn – minor: When surface colour is affected
	TOTAL MAJOR DEFECTS + SIGNIFICANT DEFECTS + MINOR DEFECTS MAY NOT EXCEED 10% OF SAMPLE SIZE
	EU Regulations: Apples must be practically free of visible soil, dust, residue or other foreign matter. Classified as a effect. Additional requirement for PinKids <sup>®</sup> Sub-Brand – Fruit size: 135 grams or smaller
